

Medication Administration- Parent's or Child's Responsibility?



Medication adherence is a challenging task for youth with sickle cell disease. There is little information about the process of transitioning medication administration responsibility from parent to the child.

The Howard University, Department of Pediatrics seeks youth with sickle cell disease, ages 10 - 21 and their parents to participate in a project involving brief surveys, a 10 minute educational session, and introduction to a phone app for sickle cell. The initial visit will take approximately 30 minutes. You will then be asked to complete a few very brief follow up surveys over the next 6 months.
